# Materials

- Natural or Synthetic Yarn.
- Knitting Needles.

# Knitted Rectangle Sizes

Size	Outer pouch (Natural or Synthetic Yarn)
	Length (cm) x Width (cm)
Extra small	20 x 36
Small	27 x 44
Medium	35 x 55

# Instructions

1. Knit a rectangle of Yarn according to measurements above.
2. Fold fabric in half widthways, placing right sides together.
3. Stitch the side & bottom edges together to form a pouch.
